- L. Executive session for Real Estate to discuss acquisition of property for electric department. Recommend 20-minute session to include Mayor, Council, City Attorney, City Administrator, Electric Director and Public Works Director.
 - Motion by Sheldon DeLange, seconded by Lucas Stansbury to go into executive session for real estate to discuss acquisition of property for electric department for no longer than 20 minutes to include Mayor, Council, City Attorney, City Administrator, Electric Director and Public Works Director. Motion carried.
 - Mayor Pyle returned the meeting to regular session following the 20-minute executive session.
 - Motion by Sheldon DeLange, seconded by Lucas Stansbury to allow the electric director to get bids for a building. Motion carried.
 - Motion by Lucas Stansbury, seconded by Bill Huston to approve the city attorney to draw up a contract to sell a city building in the amount of \$135,000.00. Motion carried.
